Program and invited the Commissioners to get involved individually or as a group. Benjamin and Sarah reviewed the membership information.

Staff Liaison Elise could not get the sound to work on the video share. She will send the link to the videos in the meeting announcements. Elise reported that the virtual event served 75 students (sophomores and juniors) from the Richmond High School Law Academy.
