SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- **SPYC Design 2.0-** Vice Chair Kristy informed Commissioners that the San Pablo Summer intern Program will resume June 2022.
- **Back to School Closet-** Vice Chair Kristy reported that the Back to School Closet during the Back to School Closet Subcommittee, on August 4th, Commissioners reviewed the survey results, decided on the stress ball, decided on the Back to School Closet labels, and began shopping for the Helms students. Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners that she would send a text, when all the items were delivered, to see if any of the Commissioners were interested to come outside of City Hall, to build the bundles.
- **Treasurer Report-** Treasurer Pablo was absent, so the Treasurer Report was continued. Staff Liaison Elise shared that Commissioners budgets have been restored: Supplies \$7,000, Sundry (Food) \$4,250, Back to School Closet \$1,000 and Youth Summit \$4,000. Elise also reported that the Commissioner have received the \$1,500, from Travis Credit Union, for the Back to School Closet Sponsorship.

OLD BUSINESS

- **City Hall Career Interest-** Assistant to the Staff Liaison Daniel shared with the Commissioners about what he and Pablo were working on, to prepare for informational interviews with City Hall staff.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Interview New Recruits-** Vice Chair Kristy welcomed new recruits Maricela and Ricky, who are moving forward with appointment by City Council.
- **City Council Appointment-** Vice Chair Kristy shared the SPYC roster. The Commissioners currently have six seeking reappointment, two new appointments, two undecided.
- **Presentation to City Council-** Vice Chair Kaitlyn asked for volunteers to present to City Council, during appointments, on September 20th. Public Relations Officer Cristian described his experience presenting in February. Staff Liaison Elise shared the February presentation, and discussed Youth Commissioners commitment to present. Commissioners Ricky, Maricela, Samantha, and Daniel volunteered to present to City Council. A subcommittee was set for Thursday, August 12th, 5-6pm, on Zoom, to begin to work on the PowerPoint.
- **Family Giving Tree Backpacks-** Vice Chair Kristy reminded Commissioners that they can pick up backpacks on Friday, August 13th, from City Hall.
- **SPYC Recruitment-** Vice Chair Kristy announced that SPYC flyers went out during an event at WIC and during National Night Out. Staff Liaison Elise encouraged Commissioners to inform the Commission if there were recruitment opportunities at their school site.
