- SPYC Design 2.0- Staff Liaison Elise has continued to work on the proposed Program Goals 2018-2020.
Goal #1: Internship Program: Youth, School & Community Partnerships (YSCP)
 Bertha and Elise are working on the summer 2019 program. Staff Liaison Elise will

inform the Commissioners about new upcoming opportunity.

Goal #2: Scholarship Concept: Staff is currently researching scholarship programs offered by other cities. The scholarship design was pushed back due to the shortage of staff and changes within City Council. Elise will be working to set a date this spring

Goal #3: Civic Engagement: Elise was eager to announce that YSCP is looking to be fully staffed again, for the new year. This will allow the Commissioners to plan any group trips to visit neighboring Commissions or colleges.

- Youth Summit 2019-Chair Marlen informed the Commissioners about the challenges executing the Commissioners' proposed themes Staff Liaison Elise proposed of talking about transitioning and different activities that will help prepare them for high school. Staff Liaison Elise discussed different methods that Commissioners could use to help support more students for our Youth Summit.
