APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

- Minutes were approved for the regular meeting held on Thursday, June 6th, 2019.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Mr. Hindler- Mr. Hindler encouraged the Commissioners to attend the West County Mayors Meeting. He congratulated the Commissioners for their presentation to Council last month. Mr. Hindler also mentioned an opportunity for Commissioners to exercise their civic engagement in Texas.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- SPYC Design 2.0- Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners about the status of the San Pablo Summer Intern Program applicants. She also stated that YSCP staff will be looking forward to meeting with the Youth Commissioners, in the fall, to create a proposal for the San Pablo scholarship concept. Staff Liaison Elise informed the Commissioners that if they are interested in visiting neighboring Commissions, that they should begin to discuss which Commissions.

- Collection's Drive 2019- Vice Chair Valentino reported on the discussions of the subcommittee last Tuesday. He informed the Commissioners of the new ideas/suggestions that were presented in order to make this event more teen-friendly.

OLD BUSINESS

- College Tour 2019- Chair Kimyatta commented on her experience with the Commission's college tour at Sacramento State. She brought up her interest in the Criminal Justice Department, and mentioned some unique things about this institution. Public Relations Officer Ignacio also described his interests in the University, including Government and International Communications.
