

LIABILITY WAIVER FORMS

All activities and classes within the Community Services Division of the City of San Pablo require a yearly Liability Waiver.

REQUEST FOR ACCOMMODATION

The City of San Pablo Community Services Department is committed to accommodating specific and appropriate access needs for safe participation in programs and activities to our public. Please submit a request for accommodation at least 10 business days prior to the scheduled program.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS/TRANSFERS

Refund requests will only be considered up to five days before the class starts and will incur a \$10 cancellation fee. Programs may be canceled or combined due to low enrollment. If the City cancels a program and the customer cannot transfer to another, a full refund will be issued.

WAITLIST PROCESS

If a program is full, you can add your child to the waitlist. If a spot opens, you'll be notified by phone, and spots are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. You have 24 hours to respond to the offer, and the registration must be completed with full paperwork and payment. If you don't respond or choose not to enroll, the next person on the waitlist will be contacted. Being on the waitlist does not guarantee enrollment.


