Conducts hearings for investigation and review of amendments to the City's General Plan. Report findings and recommendations to the City Council. Investigates, review and report findings/ recommendations to the City Council on the design and improvements of proposed major subdivisions. Investigates, review and report findings/ recommendations to the Council in regards to either the creation of any proposed redevelopment area within the City of proposed amendments to any existing redevelopment project. Conduct design review proceedings for commercial and large multi-family residential projects (outside of existing redevelopment areas). Design review includes review of the architectural design of the project, site landscape design, and the design and location of any proposed signs.
